DEVELOPMENT:

- 1. Focuses on faces.
- 2. Follows objects briefly.
- 3. Hold and talk to your baby this is the best developmental stimulation.

NUTRITIONAL:

- 1. Breast milk or formula with iron alone is adequate until 4-6 months.
- 2. Tri-vi-sol or Poly-vi-sol vitamins for breast fed babies.

ILLNESS:

- 1. Buy a thermometer and know how to use it.
- 2. If taking temperature axillary (under arm), hold five minutes. If taking temperature rectally, hold thermometer in rectum for three minutes.
- 3. Call if axillary temperature is 100° or greater or rectal temperature is 101° or greater (in babies two months or younger).
- 4. When reporting temperature do not add or subtract a degree—just tell us where the thermometer was placed (axilliary, rectally, or ear) and what the thermometer registers.
